These are the PSR and Covid-19 protocols we have been given from our Diocese:

*The Diocese of Springfield in Illinois advises parents to take into consideration the CDC, IDPH, local health department, and their family doctor guidance when making decisions about the health and safety of their children. The choice to wear a mask can be encouraged, but exemptions should be considered for medical conditions, difficulty breathing, or other concerns. No child should be turned away from PSR due to their inability to tolerate wearing a mask. Mask exceptions provided for may prompt participants or parents to ask about the medical/personal health information of another participant. It is inappropriate to disclose such private information. Each individual has a right to privacy and protection of personal health information. Each PSR community should review their safety guidelines and policies and determine the best practices for their community and location concerning safe distancing, handwashing, sickness screening, cleaning protocols, quarantining, and scheduling. It remains the responsibility of each community to determine the mitigations and measures appropriate and practical for the local situation, volunteers, physical layout of the campus, etc. Public identification of those who are or are not vaccinated against Covid-19 is not permitted. Vaccination status against Covid-19 may not be a basis for disparate treatment and no action should be taken against, or required of, an individual or child that would identify their vaccination status. Vaccination status against Covid-19 may not be a requirement of eligibility to participate. Since the situation is ever changing and updates are coming out frequently, I ask that you be vigilant in monitoring the situation in your community and watch for any additional updates from the Catholic Pastoral Center and/or this office if necessary. If you have any questions, please contact me. I am available and happy to address specific questions and provide consultation as you make your plans.*

As we begin another year of teaching the Faith and spreading the Good News, amidst old and new challenges, you will be in my prayers. I hope these passages (one from our Lord and the other from St. Paul) will bring you peace and joy!
